# PRACTICAL GUIDE

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#### 1. <u>The venue</u>

Faculty of Political Sciences is located in Jove Ilica Street No. 165 in Belgrade municipality of Vozdovac.


If you are coming by public transportation from Belgrade downtown, the easiest way to reach the Faculty is by trams No. 9, 10, 14 or busses No. 33, 47 and 48. All trams, as well as the buss 33, stop in the Vojvode Stepe Street, which is parallel to the Jove Ilica Street, while busses 47 and 48 stop in the Bulevar Oslobodjenja Street.

Tickets can be bought from the vehicle's driver (more expensive) or at kiosks market with a ticket sales sticker (BusPlus), and must be validated upon entering the vehicle. The distance between the Faculty and Belgrade downtown is about 5 km. Taxi drive should cost around 7 EUR during the daytime and up to 10-12 EUR at night/weekend.

#### - Taxi from to/the airport

In order to enhance taxi service from Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport, the Assembly of City of Belgrade is introducing ongoing project aiming to organize new taxi service regulation system from Belgrade Airport. As a part of this project, the price of a taxi service from the airport is divided into five zones.

For the use of taxi services from Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport to any destination in Belgrade area and further, please contact the city service TAXI INFO, which is located in the baggage claim area.

Please take a taxi receipt at the information desk which contains the name of your destination and appropriate price for the taxi service.

#### 3. Money exchange, shops, restaurants

The official currency in Serbia is dinar, abbreviated RSD. Money can be exchanged in all authorized exchange offices, which are plenty around the city, as well as in banks and posts. Dinar is issued in denominations of 10/20/50/100/200/500/1000/5000.

The current exchange rate may be checked on the website of the National Bank of Serbia

Cash may be taken from ATMs installed in all major malls, bank branch offices and in public places.

Shops are open whole day (usually from 09:00 or 10:00 to 20:00 or 21:00, sometimes even later), Saturdays, often Sundays (particularly in large shopping malls, such is Usce <a href="http://www.usceshoppingcenter.com/">http://www.usceshoppingcenter.com/</a> ).
